on!*

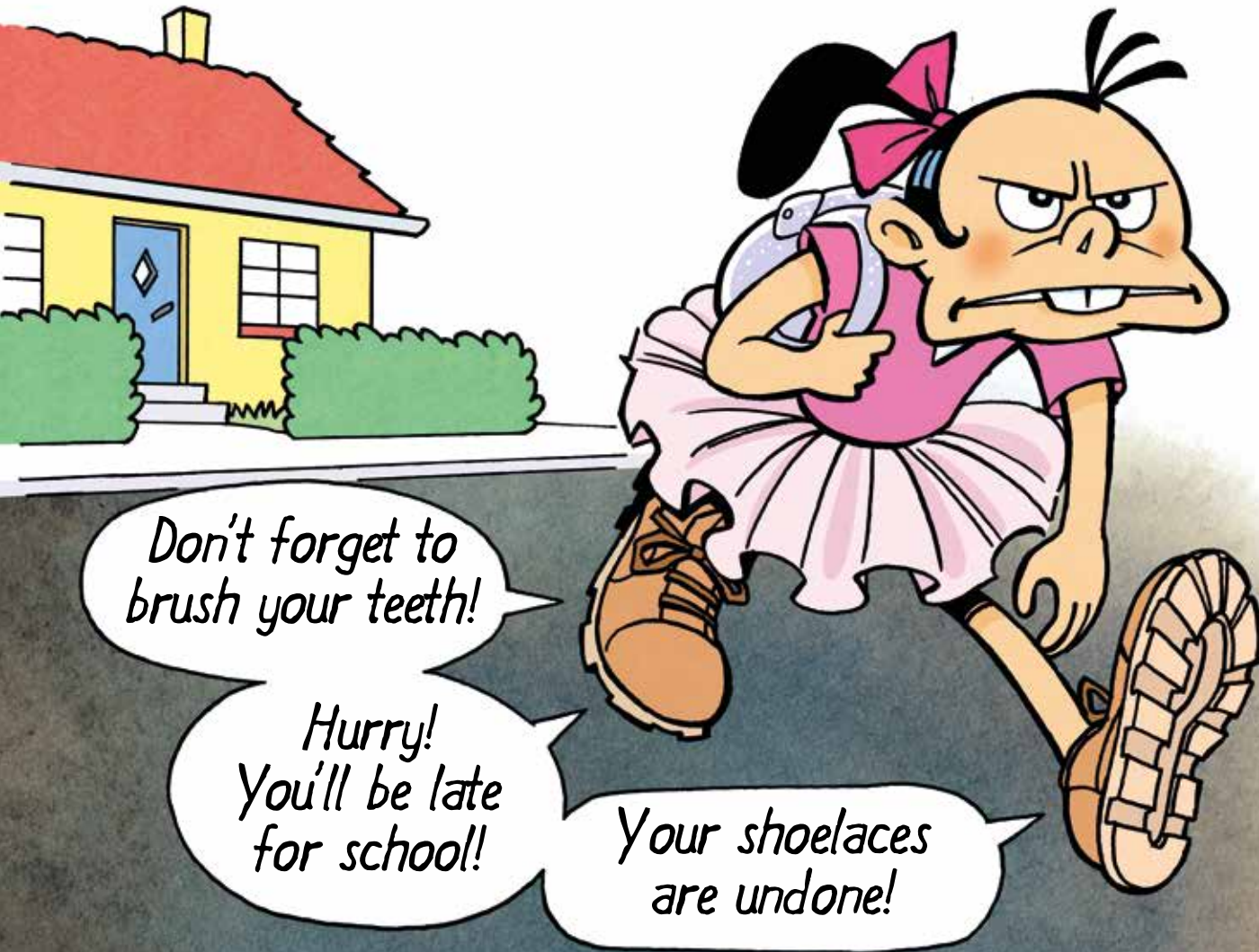
Sussi felt immediately,

each other!



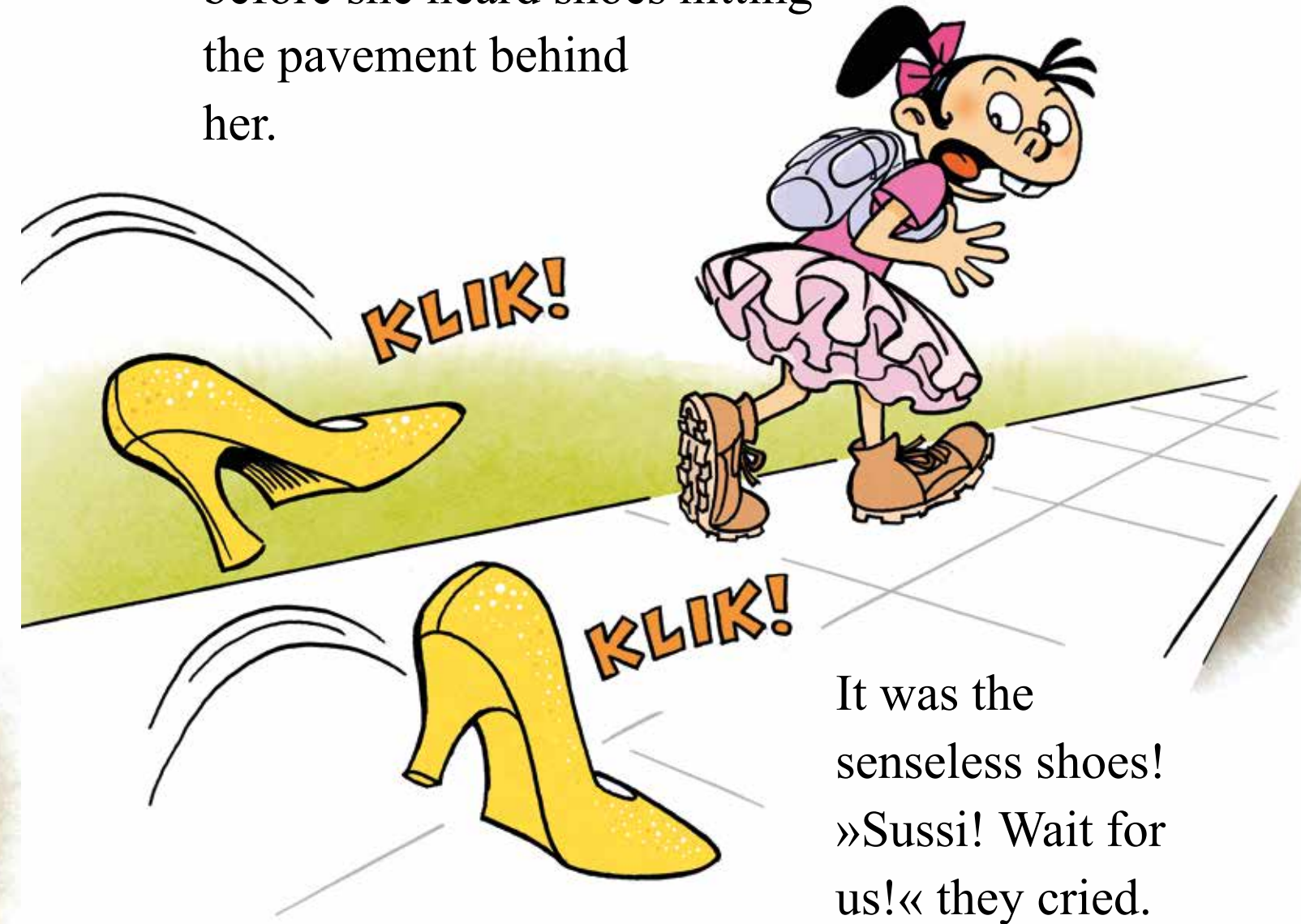
But then Mum said

her.

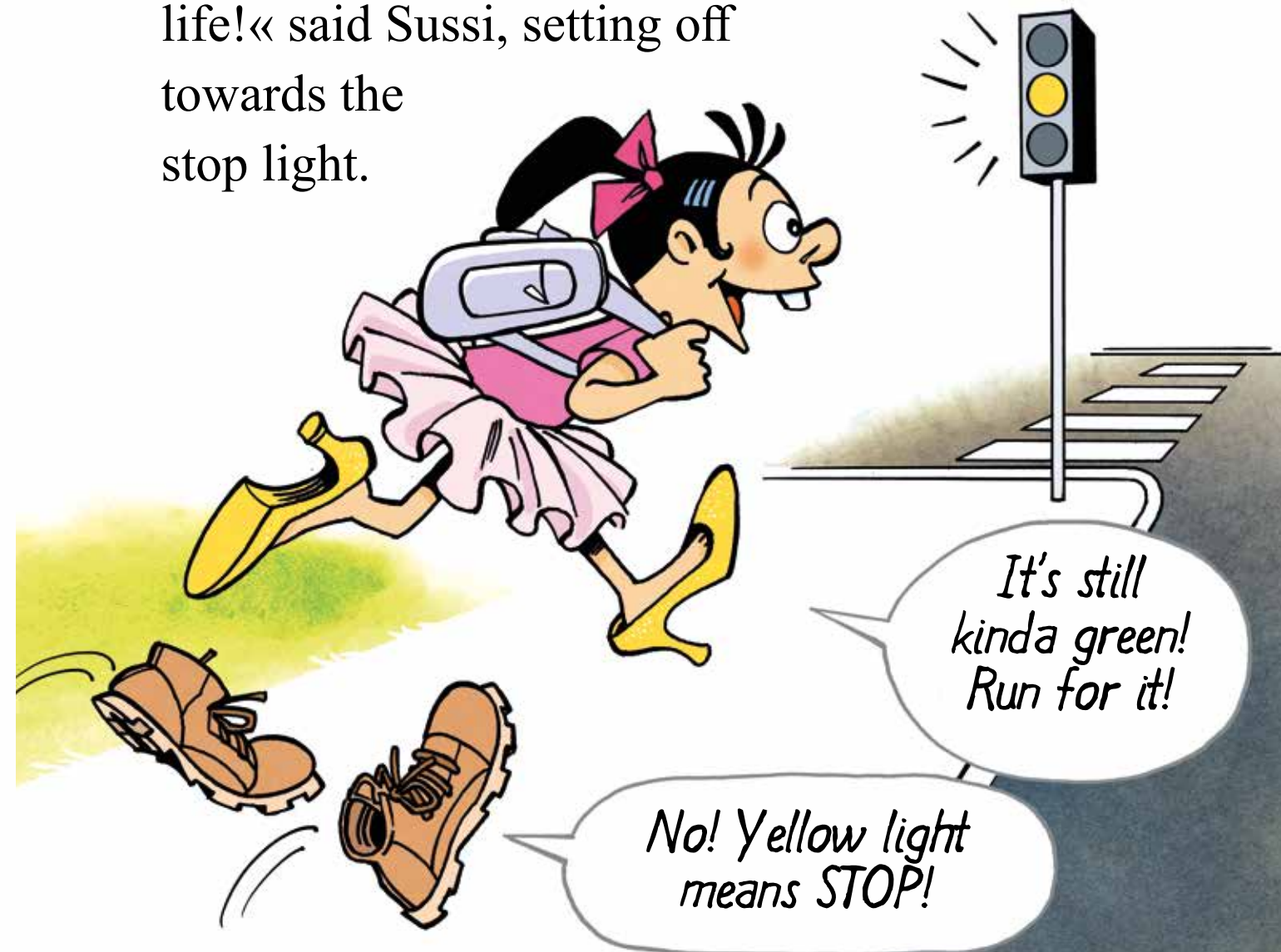


It was the
